Jesus invites us to overcome our attachment to this life and to the earth. Invite us to prepare ourselves to be with Him forever. Invite us to work constantly for our conversion and salvation. There is something different, special, and better for all of us and for our souls: HEAVEN.

Jesus was lifted, raised up...but also ONLY JESUS can restore us and restore our dignity as children of God. Jesus can give us the strength when we needed it the most.

One of the things I did at that moment and after praying was to play and to listen the song YOU RAISE ME UP and it helped me so much...and especially the verse that says I AM STRONG, WHEN I AM ON YOUR SHOULDERS. YOU RAISE ME UP TO MORE THAN I CAN BE. I made it home and drove to the ER...He raised me up so many times in my life and He will lift you up when others don't see or don't care you are feeling down physically or spiritually.

I don't know what is going on in your life right now and you might feel a little down or that someone betrayed you or someone let you down...Ask Jesus to lift you up and to give you the strength and the hope you need in your life right now. Ask Jesus to raise you up...to raise your faith, to raise your strength and to raise your hope. Ask the Lord to raise your faith in Him and to raise up your love for Him.

And of course, Happy Mother's Day to those who gave us the love, the care, and the companionship we need in our lives. You are such a great gift and a sweet blessing in our lives.

Pope Francis encouraged everyone to gratefully recall their mothers on Sunday. He expressed his appreciation for women who have given birth to children and entrusted them to the protection of Our Lady.

"Let us recall with gratitude and affection all mothers, those who are still with us and those who have gone to Heaven," said the Pope. "Let us entrust them to Mary, the mother of Jesus."


