SACRED HEART NEWS

The major theme for this weekend is LOVE and God's love particularly. We all have experienced human love in so many ways and I hope God's love in a powerful way.

We know that God is loving, kind and merciful. He keeps loving us regardless if we acknowledge and accept His unconditional love. It is important to remember that we are being loved by God and we can access His love at any time. We do not have to do anything extraordinary to receive His love. We must present ourselves as we are because God's heart loves us all and accepts our limitations and brokenness.

If we read and contemplate not only our history of salvation but our own lives, we can see many loving moments where God's love was present to comfort us, to empower us, and to lift us up.

He uses events and people to express his love and concern for us. A few times, when I was feeling worried or down, or frustrated, he surprised me through my prayer, the Eucharist. A lot of times through creation and multiple times through the love and smile of a child from the Church or the School. I am so grateful for his presence and his love. I am so grateful for the love I receive each morning and each day from so many sources, such as my family, friends, church members, and sometimes strangers at the store, gas station, restaurants, and public places.

We need to accept and welcome God's love in our lives and at the same time, become instruments and ambassadors of love. WE are invited to bring God's presence but also God's love to those who are lonely, abandoned or neglected. Our mission involves preaching the Good News, but we must recognize the kind of audience we are preaching to. Many of them are totally wounded and totally unloved. I believe one of the first messages we should deliver is YOU ARE NOT ALONE; GOD IS WITH YOU. HE LOVES YOU UNCONDITIONALLY AND WILL NEVER ABANDON YOU.

To bring Jesus and his message of love, hope and liberation we must support our Bishop and his initiatives, his ministries. Every year we have the opportunity to do it by praying and supporting the DDF campaign that helps us to outreach our brothers and sisters in distress. It is one of the many ways we can respond to God's love. Another way is with our gratitude with God for the many blessings he gives us daily. There are different ways we can get involved with the DDF. First, pray from now on for the success of the campaign. Second, pass the word and help us to motivate others. We have our goal for the Church plus a second goal is to increase the number of families participating in the campaign. I was so embarrassed last year asking families to double their pledge so we can complete the goal. If more families get involved and participate, we can decrease the amount of the pledge we have to submit. Please consider not only praying but also helping us. Let us give with the best of our ability but let us GIVE. Thank you so much for your generosity.

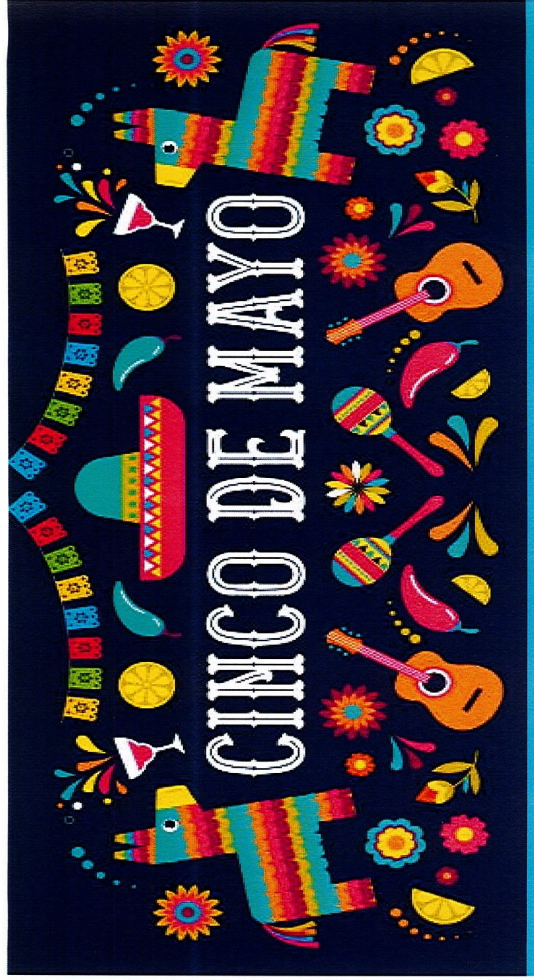



Eucharist to Sick & Homebound

Any vessel used to contain the Blessed Eucharist was called a "Pyx." Now it refers to the small container used to bring Communion to the sick and homebound. It is made either of gold or gilded silver, is flat and slightly larger than the host. When a person is unable to attend Mass and desires to receive the Eucharist, an extraordinary minister or priest uses a **Pyx** to bring them Communion. It is also used by the priest for administering **Viaticum**, the last reception of the Holy Eucharist by a dying person. Although small, the **Pyx** plays an essential role in bringing the joy of the Eucharist to those who are prevented from participating in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass.
