Welcome to our 12th week in ordinary time.

How stormy is your life?

Storms are part of everyone's life and if you have not experienced them yet, count your blessings. Storms are real and they can arrive in our lives at any time. And the main issues with storms are that they are so unpredictable even though sometimes we anticipate saying "I SEE A STORM COMING INTO MY LIFE OR MY FAMILY." Storms wake up our doubts, our fears and our worries in such a terrible way. That happens because there is a fine line between FAITH AND FEAR that most of us ignore or cross too fast.

I took a cruise from Vancouver to San Diego and one of the nights was so stormy and I understood a little what the disciples went through in today's Gospel. And I remember the first two things I did were embracing my fear and second recalling today's Gospel. It was so unreal how the ship was in the middle of the night surrounded by darkness, fog, giant waves, and hundreds of eyes watching the storm through the small windows of our cruise. I remember looking at people's faces and how they said their hearts were totally pounding in their chest. I walked to the chapel, and I prayed for our safety instead of embracing their fear and their concern. I embraced my faith and I accepted to believe that Jesus would rebuke the storm that night.

How stormy is your life?

Jesus cares for you and your storms, for the big and small waves tossing you so hard and so fearful. He will be holding you until you recover the peace and the calm most needed in your life. Let Jesus help you and take you to the other side. And the other side might be exactly what you need in your life right now.

Jesus said: "LET US CROSS TO THE OTHER SIDE." That represents not just an invitation but a very important decision and choice for us. We can choose Him, the quietness, the peace, and the calmness or we can keep navigating our personal and familiar storms. Are we willing to follow Jesus to the other side?

Jesus can take us to a safe place if we choose to follow Him and accept his invitation to walk in faith and to leave the storms we face every day of our lives.

How stormy is your life? Jesus is telling you, "LET US CROSS TO THE OTHER SIDE." I know how much you have been afraid and worried. Let me carry you in my arms. Let us show Jesus that we can turn from fear into faith with His presence, His help, and His invitation.

May the Lord guide you and protect you. May the Lord bring you faith and comfort. May the Lord help you to open your heart to see the opportunity to go TO THE OTHER SIDE WITH HIM.

Lord, I want to go to the other side with you. The storm of my life seems so frightening. I need your love, your company, and your protection. Amen.


