I love hospital ministry and helping not just those who are sick but their families as well. I really enjoy spending time trying to comfort those struggling with all kinds of illnesses. It's the most rewarding thing in my ministry.

Our readings invite us to acknowledge how loving and caring our God is with us. He wants to love us and protect us. He is with us all the time and especially in times of distress.

We know that there are many illnesses and conditions that only God can heal and restored. I have witnessed so many times how hate and resentments are related to many aches in our bodies and souls. We feel our minds and hearts with all kinds of things trying to solve our problems. We must rely in God's love and compassion for us! We must remember that our God is a God that loves us and loves our lives.

St. Paul reminds us on the importance of being generous with others. We can sacrifice our time and lives for others and especially those who are sick, lonely, and neglected. St. Paul was encouraging people to be generous with those in need and especially the poor. But we can see among us people who are "poor" in so many ways and not only financially.

I know brothers and sisters rich in wealth but so poor in love, charity and compassion. I know many brothers and sisters squandering resources and taking things for granted such as food, electricity, water, and time.

We are encouraged to be generous because many people don't have even enough water, food, and electricity.

I am visiting my family in Colombia, and I was touched by a story of a teacher who asked her class: how many of you did brush your teeth before school? Almost every one of them raised their hands. But there was a little boy who didn't raise his hand. The teacher asked him why he didn't brush his teeth...his answer touched the class and the teachers heart...and I got tears in my eyes. He told the teacher that he and his brother share a toothbrush and his brother spent too much time brushing his teeth and he chose to be on time for school. He said he was planning to brush his teeth after school because he knew the toothbrush would be available for him.

Things we take for granted! A toothbrush!

How many toothbrushes do you have, or do you need?

For how long do you live the water running while brushing your teeth?

There's another thing we take for granted, our health. Our gospel reminds us of the importance of taking care of ourselves and taking care of our families. We need healthy habits, healthy disciples, healthy families and healthy communities!

The Gospel challenges us to seek Jesus all the time and not just for a miracle. Second, not to seek for Jesus as the last resource, we must approach Him first.

Two stories, two miracles...how long has been your life and your heart "bleeding"?

I would like to invite you to approach Him this week with faith and hope.

Ofer Him your bleeding wounds and allow him to close that wound.


