## Sacred Heart News

It is a pleasure to begin my time with you here at Sacred Heart. I look forward to continuing the good work of Fr. Paco as we strive to grow in holiness together. I am very appreciative of the great welcome I have received; I know it is going to be a great time here.

On Tuesday we will celebrate the feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel. By the 12th century, a group of hermits had taken up residence in the hills surrounding Mount Carmel, the place where Elijah defeated the gods of Baal. This group eventually became what is today the Carmelites, the order of St. John of the Cross, Theresa of Avila, and countless other saints. Since sometime in the 15th century, the devotion to Our Lady of Mount Carmel has increased and the use of the Brown Scapular has become prevalent today. If you do not wear a brown

scapular, I would encourage you to take up this devotion and to be enrolled in the brown scapular.



While the devotion became popular in the 15th century, it began in the mid-13th century when Our Lady appeared to St. Simon Stock and promised eternal life to those who wore the Carmelite habit. She said, "This shall be a privilege for you and all Carmelites, that anyone dying in this habit shall not suffer eternal fire." These privileges were then extended to all in the Church and still today those who wear the Scapular faithfully and meet the conditions of living a life of chastity and observe the fasts of the Church are recipients of the same promise.

A visit to Mount Carmel is well worth it! Atop the mountain is an outstanding statue of Elijah defeating the gods of Baal, the false gods to whom the Israelites too often turned. As we celebrate our Lady of Mount Carmel, let us turn away from the false gods we all too often worship and turn back to the God who created heaven and earth, the God who became man and was born of the Virgin Mary, who wraps us in her loving embrace and guides us along the path of discipleship.

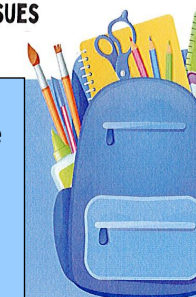
